Registry has raised an objection that translation of the impugned judgment is not enclosed and the number of days by which appeal is delayed has not been indicated in the delay condonation application.</p> <p>4. Since appellant is in jail and appeal has been filed through legal aid counsel, we, therefore, overrule the objections raised by the Registry and condone the delay. Accordingly, delay condonation application (IA No.1/2025) is allowed. However, English translation shall be filed by legal aid counsel for the appellant as and when required by the Court.</p> <p>7.
