Petitioner claims to be Mutawali of a Waqf, which is registered with Uttarakhand Waqf Board. By means of this writ petition, he has sought the following reliefs: -<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>(i) Issue a writ, order of direction in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 18<sup>th</sup> August, 2017 passed by the respondent no. 2 and Show Cause Notice dated 10<sup>th</sup> September 2018 issued by the private respondent (respondent no. 3).</li><li>(ii) Issue, Writ, Order or direction in the nature of mandamus commanding the respondent no. 1 &amp; 2 to appoint full time Chief Executive Officer of Uttarakhand Waqf Board according to law.</li></ol></li><li>5. Ms. Nishant Intezar, learned counsel for Uttarakhand Waqf Board submits that a new Managing Committee of Waqf No. 384, 385 &amp; 386 has been constituted on 10.02.2026. Thus, she submits that writ petition has become infructuous. The order dated 10.02.2026 produced by Ms. Nishant Intezar is taken on record.</li><li>6.
