Her preference was Indian Police Service, but it has been denied to her on</p>

the ground of less height.

It is the case of the petitioner that Rule 8(3) of the Regulations Relating to the Medical Examination of Candidates for the Civil Services Examination, 2024 (“the Regulations”), has been wrongly read by the respondent-authorities by denying the benefit of the Regulations to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the Central Administrative Tribunal had directed that one post of IPS cadre arising from Civil Services Examination, 2024, be kept vacant, but since now the Original Application has already been decided, further interim order is required till the disposal of the case, one post of the Indian Police Service (IPS) in Civil Service Examination, 2024, be kept vacant.

Having considered, as an interim measure, till the next date of listing, one post of IPS in Civil Service Examination, 2024, shall be kept vacant.

Interim relief application stands disposed of, accordingly.
