The matter dates back to 29.11.2024, and for a long time matter was pending for curing the defects. As per the office report dated 02.04.2026, defects have been removed.</p> <p>3. There is a delay condonation application (IA No.1/2026) has been filed by the learned counsel for the Appellant.</p> <p>4. Heard on the delay condonation application. The reason so assigned for the delay is firstly that the Appellant is a senior citizen aged about 70 years. Secondly, he was ill and accordingly could not proceed with the appeal (leave to appeal).</p> <p>5. Learned counsel for the Appellant also submits that there is an anomaly of describing the period of delay. The delay pertains to only 60 days.</p> <p>6. Learned counsel for the Appellant is requested to correct the said anomaly as orally it is said to be 60 days whereas as on record it is 493 days of delay. Let the said anomaly be expressed specifically regarding the days' and counts by the next date fixed.</p> <p>7. Issue notice to the respondent on the delay condonation application.
