Mr. Virendra Singh Rawat, learned counsel for respondent no. 3. 4. Petitioner participated for selection to the post of Assistant Teacher in Atal Utkrisht Rajkiya Madhyamik Vidyalaya. 5. As per the contention of the petitioner, after the declaration of the result, the provisional answer key was published by the Board. In same publication/declaration of result, the respondent no. 3, UBSE invited objections from the candidates. In this regard, the petitioner submitted five objections regarding discrepancies in the published answer key. Petitioner gave objection in respect of five questions being Question nos. 31, 37, 42, 46 and 55. 6. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the Board considered the objection and found that the options given by the petitioner in respect of question nos. 37 and 55 were correct and two marks were given to him, but, options regarding question no. 31, 42 and 46 were rejected. 7.
