Mr. Aakash Sanyal, learned counsel holding the brief of Mr. Aditya Singh, learned counsel for the petitioner. 2. Mr. Tumul Nainwal, learned A.G.A. for the State. 3. The Hon'ble Supreme Court by judgment and order dated 25.06.2025, remand this matter in order to expedite the same by directing the Collector, Haridwar to conduct a personal inquiry with regard to the management of the Math, after hearing all the parties. The Collector, Haridwar was also directed that he shall focus on the best interest of the Math and its devotees and submit a report to the High Court.

		<p>6. In compliance to the Hon'ble Apex Court's directions the Collector, Haridwar placed its report. The Hon'ble Apex Court also directed the BKTC to give up-to-date report to the High Court and keep on submitting periodic updated report.</p> <p>7. Put up this matter on 26.02.2026. By that time, BKTC also place before this Court updated report as per the direction of the Hon'ble Apex Court.</p> <p>8. Mr. Tumul Nainwal, learned A.G.A. for the State informed this Court that in WPCRL NO. 1679 of 2025, the petitioner, namely, Mahant Rohit Giri is not cooperating with the investigation, though, Mahant Rohit Giri was given protection by the Coordinate Bench subject to this condition that he will cooperate with the investigation.</p> <p>9. Learned counsel for Mahant Rohit Giri make a statement that he will join the investigation today itself and also in future date.</p> <p>10. Earlier, investigation is being carried out in FIR No. 49 of 2025 and Mr. Tumul Nainwal, learned A.G.A. apprise this Court that in this FIR charge sheet has been filed and eight persons have been exonerated and two persons have been charge sheeted. So far as other two FIRs, i.e. FIR No. 308 of 2025 and FIR No. 139 of 2025 are concerned, in FIR No. 318 of 2025, Mr. Tumul Nainwal already apprise to this Court that Mahant Rohit Giri is not cooperating with the investigation, though, now statement has been given by learned counsel that Mahant Rohit Giri shall join the investigation today itself and also on future date. So far as another FIR No. 1319 of 2025 is concerned, Mr. Tumul Nainwal, learned A.G.A. seeks time to</p>
