Present criminal appeal is filed against the judgment and order dated 01.12.2023 passed by the court of learned Special Session Judge, POCSO, Pithoragarh in Special Session Trial No.22 of 2019 under Section 354 of IPC and Section 7/8 of POCSO. By the said judgment under Section 354 of IPC appellant has been sentenced to undergo five years rigorous imprisonment alongwith fine of Rs.20,000/- and in default stipulation one year additional rigorous imprisonment was imposed; under Section 7/8 of the POCSO Act appellant has been sentenced to undergo five years rigorous imprisonment alongwith fine of Rs.20,000/- and in default stipulation one year additional rigorous imprisonment was imposed.</p> <p>4. Heard learned counsel for the parties.</p> <p>5. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that appellant was on bail during trial.</p> <p>6. Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is of the view that appellant is entitled to be released on bail.</p>

7. Accordingly, bail application is allowed. Let the appellant-Jai Shankar Titiyal be released on bail on his executing a personal bond and two reliable sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the court concerned.

8. Appellant is exempted from filing the affidavit of pairokar in support of the bail application.

9. Exemption application stands disposed of.
