Mr. Saurabh Kumar Pandey, learned counsel for the applicants. 2. Mr. Akshay Latwal, learned Brief Holder for the State. 3. These two applications have been preferred under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, challenging the proceeding of Criminal Case No. 2453 of 2025 titled as State of Uttarakhand vs. Gurvinder Singh and Others pending in the court of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate/First Additional Civil Judge (S.D.) Rudrapur, District Udham Singh Nagar, wherein, they are facing trial for the offences punishable under Sections 85, 115(2), 351(2), 352 and 333 of BNS, 2023 r/w Section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961. 4. C528 No. 2330 of 2025 has been preferred by father-in-law and C528 Application No. 2331 of 2025 is preferred by husband of complainant/respondent no. 2. 5. It is argued by the learned counsel for the applicant that Gurvinder Singh the applicant of C528 Application No. 2331 of 2025 married with respondent no. 2 on 17.10.2020, however there was some dispute in between both of them due to which both are living separately since 28.09.2024 and there are no issues from their marriage. It is submitted that the husband still intended to live with the respondent wife for which he has filed a suit for restitution of conjugal rights in the Family Court, Rudrapur. He submits that so far as the FIR lodged by respondent no. 2 is concerned the allegations are false and frivolous and still there are chances of their amicable settlement. 6. Taking into consideration that the dispute in between the parties appears to be a matrimonial dispute, therefore, efforts may be made for their amicable settlement. 7. Learned Brief Holder Mr. Akshay Latwal accepts
