1. Heard Sri Subham Singh, learned counsel for the applicant, learned A.G.A. for the State and perused the record.
2. The present application under Section 528 B.N.S.S. has been filed with a prayer to allow this application and quash the entire further criminal proceeding in Criminal Case No. 2315 of 2012 (State of U.P. Vs. Om Prakash Soni) arising out of charge sheet dated 20.03.2012 and summoning order dated 19.12.2012 and as well as Non Bailable Order Dated 30.04.2022 against the offence registered in Case Crime No. 87 of 2012 u/s 498-A I.P.C. and 3/4 D.P. Act, Police Station Bairia, District Ballia, pending before Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate 2nd, District Ballia.
3. Learned counsel for the applicant states that the applicant consents to refer the matter to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, High Court, Allahabad for the amicable settlement of the matrimonial dispute.
4. Accordingly, the matter is referred to Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court. The applicant is directed to deposit a sum of Rs. 25,000/- by way of Demand Draft/Pay Order in the name of Allahabad High Court Mediation & Conciliation Centre (AHCMCC) within a period of four weeks from today. Out of total amount, Rs. 20,000/- shall be payable to the opposite party no. 2 as legal expenses on her appearance before the Mediation & Conciliation Centre and remaining Rs. 5,000/- shall be payable to the Mediation & Conciliation Centre.
5. The matter is referred to the Mediation Centre with the direction that same

may be tried to be resolved after giving notices to both the parties. The Mediation Centre will submit its report within three months in the matter.

6. List this case on 16.07.2026 in the daily cause list alongwith the report of Mediation Centre.

7. Till then no coercive measures shall be taken against the applicant.

8. In case, the aforesaid amount is not deposited within the aforesaid period, the interim protection granted above shall automatically be vacated.
