2. Heard Sri Anil Kumar, learned counsel for the applicant, Sri Saurabh Tripathi, Advocate, holding brief of Sri Sohith Prakash Sharma, learned counsel for the opposite party no. 2, Sri Ajay Singh, learned A.G.A.-I for the State and perused the record.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant has drawn the attention of the Court to an order dated 07.10.2025 passed in Criminal Misc. Transfer Application No.462 of 2025 and the said petition is still pending disposal and till date no response has been filed by the opposite party no. 2, para-24 and annexure no.6 of the affidavit have been placed for the same.
