Re: Criminal Misc. Short Term Bail (Parole) Application No. 01 of 2026

1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant and Sri Yagvalkya Pandey, learned A.G.A. for the State-Respondent and perused the record.
2. The instant Short Term (Parole) Application has been moved on behalf of accused-applicant seeking enlargement on Parole in Case Crime No. 483 of 2025, under Sections 318(4), 338, 336(3), 340(2), 61(2) of B.N.S. and Section 66-D of the Information and Technology Act, Police Station Phase-3 Noida, District Gautam Buddh Nagar.
3. Learned Counsel for the applicant argued that the accused-applicant is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this very case crime number and is languishing in jail since 09.11.2025. Learned counsel for the applicant further submits that the applicant is the student of Class XII and his examination is scheduled to be held from 18.02.2026. A copy of the Admit Card of Class XII as well as letter of Principal of Sri Gayanand Inter College, Manikpur, Kanhepur, Farrukhabad is annexed with the Parole Application. Learned counsel for the applicant also submits that applicant may be permitted to appear in the aforesaid examination, which is scheduled to be held on 18.02.2026, as is evident from the Admit Card.
4. Learned A.G.A. has vehemently opposed the bail but could not dispute the aforesaid facts.
5. Considering the submissions made by learned counsel for the applicant and the fact that the examination of Class XII of the applicant is scheduled

to be held from 18.02.2026, therefore, the prayer for short term bail is **allowed.**

6. Let the applicant, **Sarthak Gupta**, be released on Short Term Bail (Parole) in the aforesaid case crime number from 17.02.2026 to 02.03.2026, on executing personal bond and two reliable sureties each, in the like amount to the satisfaction of the court concerned and he will surrender before the Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned on 03.03.2026 and shall be sent back to jail.

7. The Registrar (Compliance) of this Court is directed to inform the order to all concerned to ensure compliance today itself.

8. The party shall file computer generated copy of this order downloaded from the official website of High Court, Allahabad. The computer generated copy of this order shall be self attested by counsel of the party concerned.

9. The concerned Authority shall verify the authenticity of this computerized copy of the order from the official website of High Court, Allahabad, and shall make a declaration of such verification in writing.

Order on Criminal Misc. Bail Application:

Put up this bail application on 09.03.2026, as fresh along with surrender certificate, which is to be produced before this Court by the learned counsel for the applicant.
