HON'BLE AVNISH SAXENA, J.

1. Sri N.I.Jafri, learned Senior Counsel assisted by Sri Asif Ahmad, Advocate appears for the appellants and submits that the appeal is of the year 1984. The conviction is recorded against accused/appellants for offence under Section 307 IPC read with Section 149 IPC and Section 148 IPC. Out of the five accused/appellant, two have already passed away, namely, Badar Khan and Zahoor Khan. He submits, that the injured and alleged assailants are of same family. There was some family dispute between the parties, which led to lodging of FIR and subsequent conviction on the statement of injured witness. He submits that presently the parties have buried their hatchets and wants amicable solution of this long drawn legal battle. He drawn the attention of this Court towards the joint compromise, which was filed before the Court on 20.02.2020. He submits that the parties may be granted liberty to move the compromise before the C.J.M., Rampur, who may be directed to verify the said compromise.

2. Learned AGA is present for the State.

3. Considering the appeal is of 1984 pending till date, wherein two of the accused have already passed away and rest of the accused are senior citizens. This Court, hence, direct the surviving parties to appear before the trial court move a compromise, which shall be given a miscellaneous number and shall be verified by the court.

4. The parties shall file compromise before the CJM, Rampur, who may

fix a date and time for the parties to appear for its verification. The said compromise and its verification be carried out within a period of 60 days.

5. The compromise shall be filed by the informant, victim(s) and surviving accused. The copy of verified compromise alongwith order of verification shall be sent to this Court by the Chief Judicial Magistrate and the certified copy of the same shall also be filed by the appellants.

6. Registrar Compliance is required to send this order to the District Judge, Rampur for forward communication of this order.
