1. The instant criminal appeal was filed by appellants, namely, Kali Charan, Bal Mukund and Smt. Ram Devi challenging the conviction order dated 03.04.1984 passed in Sessions Trial No.131 of 1982.
2. As per office report dated 05.01.2026 along with C.J.M. report dated 12.09.2025, appellant no.2 - Bal Mukund and appellant no.3 - Ram Devi have already died.
3. Taking into consideration the said report, instant appeal *qua* appellant nos.2 and 3 is abated.
4. Sri Rahul Misra, learned counsel appearing on behalf of appellant no.1 is not ready to argue the case. Appeal is pending since 1984. The Court has left with no option, but to issueailable warrant.
5. Issueailable warrant to appellant no.1, Kalicharan through Chief Judicial Magistrate/Station House Officer of the police station concerned. If the appellant is arrested or is produced before the Court concerned, he shall be released on bail on his furnishing a personal bond of Rs.10,000/- to the satisfaction of the court concerned and on his furnishing an undertaking that he shall appear before this Court either personally or through counsel on 03.02.2026.
6. Learned counsel for appellant no. 1 has appeared and prayed for some time to prepare the case.

7. Paper book is ready and appeal is ripe up for hearing.

8. List this case on 03.02.2026 for final hearing.

9. Office is directed to communicate this order to the Chief Judicial Magistrate and S.H.O. concerned with all necessary details of appellant no.1 within three days.
