1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned A.G.A. for the State, Shri Rohit Nandan Singh, learned counsel for the respondent no.4 and perused the record.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that a purely civil dispute between the parties has illegally been dragged in criminal court by giving colour to the whole incident and as such impugned FIR is liable to be quashed.
3. Matter requires consideration.
4. Learned counsel for the respondent no.4 prays for and is granted two weeks' time to file a counter affidavit.
5. Learned AGA may file counter affidavit within the same period.

Till then the petitioner shall not be arrested, provided that he will co-operate by all means in ongoing investigation, in pursuance of the of the first information report dated 08.12.2025 giving rise to Case Crime No. 0389 of 2025, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 of I.P.C., Police Station - Karchhana, Yamunanagar, Commissionerate Prayagraj, District – Prayagraj.
