1. Case called out. None is present for the appellants. Learned AGA for the State is present.
2. As per the report of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, the appellant no.1-Naresh, appellant no. 3-Nanika, appellant no.4-Bhudeo and appellant no.8-Bhai Singh have died. There is nothing contrary to the report of the Chief Judicial Magistrate.
3. In view thereof, the proceedings of this criminal appeal is abated against appellant nos.1, 3, 4 and 8.
4. Notices have been served on appellant no. 2-Bhura, appellant no. 5-Suresh, appellant no.6-Sewak and appellant no.7-Lalaram, but neither appellant nos. 2,5,6 and 7 are present nor their learned counsel are present. They have been convicted under Section 307/149, 148 IPC. They are on bail and despite sufficient service and knowledge, they are not present.
5. Hence, letailable warrants be issued against appellant nos 2,5,6 and 7. If they appear/surrender before the CJM concerned, then they shall be released on bail with a condition that they themselves or through their counsel would appear before this Court on the next date of listing.
6. Notice shall also be issued to appellant nos. 2,5,6 and 7 why their bail may not be cancelled.

7. The concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate is directed to send compliance/service report of the appellants no. 2,5,6 and 7 to this Court within three weeks from today.

8. List this appeal after four weeks for hearing.
