1. Case called out. None has appeared on behalf of the appellants. However, learned A.G.A. for the State is present.
2. As per office report, appellant nos. 1 to 3, namely, Daya Ram @ Neta, Khemkaran and Rajjak have died. Hence, the criminal appeal on their behalf stands dismissed as abated.
3. Let non-bailable warrant be issued against appellant no. 4-Raj Pal. If he appears/surrenders before the CJM concerned, then he shall be released on bail with a condition that he himself or through his counsel would appear before this Court on the next date of listing.
4. The learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Budaun is directed to send compliance/service report of the appellant no. 4 to this Court along with covering report of the learned District & Sessions Judge by the next date of listing.
5. List this appeal after four weeks.
6. Meanwhile, District Magistrate as well as Superintendent of Police, Budaun is directed to seek living status report of the aforesaid appellant.
7. Learned A.G.A. may also follow the same.
