1. Sri Anoop Trivedi, learned Senior Advocate and Additional Advocate General for State assisted by Sri Sanjay Singh, Advocate and Sri Sameer Shanker, learned AGA-I, are present. Sri Shailendra Kumar Tripathi, learned counsel for accused applicant is present.

2. It is vehemently argued by the State at this stage that there are nine petitions and none of the petitions invoking the inherent jurisdiction of this Court, is maintainable on one ground or another. Mainly on the ground that the trial is proceeding and the prosecution evidences are being recorded. The rejection order of the discharge application has not been challenged in some of the petitions. In some of the petitions the framing of charge has not been challenged. Hence submits that there is no point of moving the counter affidavit in these petitions on the point of merit.

3. Countering the argument learned counsel for applicants of connected applications submits that there is stay order operating in some of the petitions and eight applications are connected with the same.

4. The nine applications arose out of two case crime numbers i.e. Case Crime No. 938 of 2020 wherein Gaurav Gupta is the informant and Case Crime No. 939 of 2020 wherein Mohan Agarwal is the informant.

5. In the interest of justice the matter is postponed to a later date as all the learned counsel appearing in nine cases are not present.

7. In the meantime, parties may exchange affidavits, if required.

8. The interim order, if any, is extended till the next date fixed.
