1. None has appeared on behalf of the appellants. Shri R.K. Singh, learned AGA for the State is present.
2. As per office report dated 13.3.2026, the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Banda vide his communication dated 17.12.2025, has reported that the appellant no.3-Ramadheen has died. Accordingly, the appeal stands **abated against appellant no.3**. His personal bond is cancelled and sureties are discharged.
3. Office report further reflects that appellant nos.1 and 2 could not be traced out, whereas the appellant no.4 has been informed through his mobile.
4. In the given circumstances, let bailable warrant be issued to the appellant no.4 through Chief Judicial Magistrate, Banda.
5. With regard to the appellant nos.1 and 2, it will be expedient to appoint an Amicus Curiae to argue this case on their behalf.
6. Let Shri Ashutosh Sharma, Advocate A.O.R. No. A/A-0164/2016 be appointed as Amicus Curiae to argue this case on behalf of the appellant nos.1 and 2.
7. Registry to inform Shri Ashutosh Sharma, Advocate about this order.
8. Let paper-book be prepared. Copy of the paper-book be provided to the Amicus Curiae and the learned AGA as per rules.

9. List this case on 27.4.2026 alongwith compliance report regarding bailable warrant issued today.

10. Registrar (Compliance) is directed to communicate this order to concerned CJM through District and Sessions Judge for compliance.
