1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned A.G.A. and perused the record.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is wholly innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case due to ulterior motive.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has next submitted that a civil dispute between the parties has illegally been dragged in a criminal court. Learned counsel for the petitioner has next drawn the attention of the Court to an order dated 15.9.2025 passed in ***Criminal Misc. Writ Petition No. 20573 of 2025***, filed by co-accused Mohd. Mustaq, wherein the arrest of the co-accused has already been stayed by this Court and the petitioner also deserves similar indulgence.
4. Matter requires consideration.
5. Issue notice to respondent no. 4 returnable within four weeks.
6. Learned AGA may also file counter affidavit within the said period. Rejoinder affidavit, if any, may be filed within one week thereafter.
7. List on 16.3.2026.
8. Till then, the petitioner shall not be arrested in pursuance of the impugned F.I.R. dated 30.8.2025 arising out of case crime no. 84 of 2025, under sections 318(4), 338, 336(3), 340(2), 61(2), 308(5) of BNS, P.S. Chamanganj, District Kanpur Nagar.
