Heard Shri Divyanshu Mishra, Advocate holding brief of Shri Prateek Dwivedi, learned counsel for the appellants and learned A.G.A. for the State-respondent.

As per office report dated 30.09.2024, C.J.M. Kanpur Dehat vide its letter dated 26.07.2021 has reported that the appellant no.1 namely Paras Ram has died, therefore, the present appeal stands abated qua appellant no.1 namely Paras Ram.

Learned counsel for the appellant no.2 submits that during the pendency of this appeal, the appellant no.2 namely Ram Asraey had already deposited the amount of surety before the trial court, the said fact has been stated in the paragraph no.4 of the supplementary affidavit filed on behalf of the appellants and in this regard, a report of Additional District and Sessions Judge/Special Judge (D.A.A.), Kanpur Dehat dated 11.02.2023 is also available on record. Therefore, the proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C. has been dropped against the appellant no.2 namely Ram Asarye.

Accordingly, no fruitful purpose would be served in keeping the appeal pending.

Since the amount of surety has been deposited in compliance of

he impugned order dated 05.07.1988, appeal is liable to be disposed of.

Accordingly, the appeal is **disposed of**.
