1. List revised.
2. No one appears on behalf of the appellants to press this appeal despite the fact that there are three learned counsel appearing in the matter.
3. Shri Virendra Pratap Singh, learned AGA for the State, is present.
4. The trial court records have been received. The matter is ripe for hearing.
5. The records show that three appellants namely Khalil, Raghunath and Tejbali were convicted and sentenced by the impugned judgement and order dated 24.12.1983 and appeal was preferred by them. Subsequently, an application for bail dated 06.08.1984 was preferred by Raghunath and Tejbali only, in which, vide order dated 18.09.1984, they were directed to be released on bail.
6. In so far as the third appellant- Khalil is concerned, he was directed to be released on bail, vide order dated 11.07.1984. The accused appellants thus, are on bail in the matter.
7. Since today, even in the revised call, neither the appellants are present nor there is any representation on their behalf despite three learned counsel appearing on their behalf, the bail granted to them is hereby **cancelled**.
8. Issue Non-bailable warrants against them.

9. The Chief Judicial Magistrate, Mirzapur, and the Superintendent of Police, Mirzapur, are directed to ensure compliance of the said order, forthwith and send their reports within two weeks to this Court.

10. Registrar (Compliance) of this Court and learned AGA are directed to communicate this order to the respective authorities concerned, forthwith.

11. List this matter on 21.04.2026.
