1. Case called out. No one has appeared on behalf of the appellant.

2. A report dated 01.05.2018 of the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Kanpur Nagar is on record, which shows that notices were sent for service upon the sole appellant, whereupon the police reported that the appellant had left the place and the notices were served upon him through his son. The said report is about seven years old and is very vague. The appeal has been pending since 1985.

3. In view of above, let a bailable warrant be issued against appellant, Arjun Singh, returnable within two weeks. In the event of his appearance before the C.J.M. Kanpur Nagar and upon his applying for bail, he shall be released on bail on furnishing a personal bond along with two sureties, each in the like amount, to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned with an undertaking that he shall ensure his presence before this Court, either personally or through counsel, on the next date fixed.
