HON'BLE VIVEK KUMAR SINGH, J.

1. Sri Krishna Mohan Singh, learned counsel for the appellants, is present and submits that he could not appear on the last date due to unavoidable circumstances, and consequently, a bailable warrant was issued against both the appellants. However, the same has not been executed upon them.
2. In case the bailable warrant has not been served upon the appellants, the same shall not be executed by the court concerned, since learned counsel for the appellants is present before this Court, and there is no requirement for the appellants to furnish bail bonds in pursuance of the order dated 12.01.2026.
