HON'BLE MADAN PAL SINGH, J.

1. On the matter being taken up in the revised call, no one appears for the appellant nos. 1 to 4 to press the present criminal appeal.
2. By means of the letter dated 21st June, 2021, the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kanpur Dehat has reported that appellant no.4, namely, Dularey has died.
3. Accordingly, the present appeal at the behest of appellant no.4 is abated.
4. Since the appeal is of the year 1987, letailable warrant be issued to the appellant nos.1 to 3, namely, Ayodhya Prasad, Santosh Kumar and Sunil Kumar through the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kanpur Dehat for ensuring their appearance before this Court personally or through counsel on the next date. If they choose to surrender before the C.J.M. concerned, they shall be released on bail on furnishing a personal bond of Rs. 20,000/-each with an undertaking that they will appear on the date fixed in the instant appeal personally or through their counsel. Learned C.J.M. shall submit a report and transmit photocopies of the bail bonds to this Court.
5. The Senior Superintendent of Police/Superintendent of Police, Kanpur Dehat is directed to ensure the execution of theailable warrant to be issued to the appellant nos.1 to 3 for necessary compliance of this order.
6. Office is directed to communicate the instant order to the concerned C.J.M. and the concerned Superintendent of Police within a week.
7. List this case on 9th January, 2026.
