1. Sri Santosh Kumar Yadav holding brief of Sri R.B. Sahai, learned counsel as appeared on behalf of appellant no.1. Appellant No.2 was declared abated. This criminal appeal has been filed by the appellant against the impugned order dated 10.10.1988. By the impugned order, a fine of Rs. 4,000/- each on both appellants were imposed by the trial court as they were the sureties of accused. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the appellant that the fine imposed upon the appellant was deposited by him and the same can be verified from the records.

2. This court does not find it necessary to summon the trial court records only for verifying the facts stated by the appellant. Hence, the learned District Judge, Fatehpur, will place this order before the concerned court. The concerned court, after going through the records of Session Trial No.105 of 1985 will submit its report on the fact stated by the learned counsel for the appellant.
