1. Case called out. None has appeared on behalf of the appellants. However, learned A.G.A. is present.
2. As per office report, appellant nos. 1 & 3, namely, Digvijay Singh and Shyamlal have died. Hence the criminal appeal on their behalf stands dismissed as abated.
3. Let non-bailable warrant be issued against appellant nos. 2 to 5, namely, Sri Krishna, Ram Autar and Bharose. If they appear/surrender before the CJM concerned, then they shall be released on bail with a condition that they themselves or through their counsel would appear before this Court on the next date of listing.
4. The Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hamirpur is directed to send compliance/service report of the aforesaid appellants to this Court along with covering report of the District & Sessions, Hamirpur by the next date of listing.
5. List this appeal after four weeks.
6. Meanwhile, learned AGA is directed to seek living status report of the appellant from the concerned State authorities.
