HON'BLE SAMEER JAIN, J.

1. Sri Mahipal Singh, learned Advocate filed his power on behalf of informant, today in the Court, which is taken on record.
2. Sri Narayan Singh, learned counsel for applicant, Sri Mahipal Singh, learned counsel for informant and Sri Imran Khan, learned AGA for the State are present.
3. At the very outset, learned counsel for informant submits, applicant is husband of the deceased and deceased died on 25.04.2025 and about four days before on 21.04.2025 she herself made complaint against applicant and his family members with regard to torture but application moved by deceased dated 21.04.2025 has not been annexed along with instant bail application. He prays for and is granted two weeks time to file counter affidavit.
4. In the meantime, learned AGA may also file counter affidavit disclosing entire material available on record. Rejoinder affidavit, if any, may be filed by the applicant within two weeks thereafter.
5. List this case in week commencing 16.02.2026 in the category of daily cause list.
