**HON'BLE NAND PRABHA SHUKLA, J.**

1. Heard Sri Lavlesh Kumar Shukla, learned counsel for the applicant, learned A.G.A. for the State and perused the record.
2. The present application under Section 528 B.N.S.S. has been filed with a prayer to allow this application and to quash the impugned Recovery Warrant dated 28.04.2025, Recovery Warrant/Non Bailable Warrant dated 30.08.2025 and attachment order dated 17.12.2025 respectively passed by Principal Judge, Family Court, Chandauli in Misc. Case No. 82 of 2025 (Vandana Shukla Vs. Krishna Nand Pandey) arising out of an application filed under section 147 BNSS.
3. Learned counsel for the applicant states that the applicant consents to refer the matter to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, High Court, Allahabad for the amicable settlement of the matrimonial dispute.
4. Accordingly, the matter is referred to Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court. The applicant is directed to deposit a sum of Rs. 95,000/- by way of Demand Draft/Pay Order in the name of Allahabad High Court Mediation & Conciliation Centre (AHCMCC) within a period of four weeks from today. Out of total amount, Rs. 90,000/- shall be payable to the opposite party no. 2 on her appearance before the Mediation & Conciliation Centre and remaining Rs. 5,000/- shall be payable to the Mediation & Conciliation Centre. The amount paid to the opposite party no. 2 shall be adjusted towards the arrears due to be paid.
5. The matter is referred to the Mediation Centre with the direction that same may be tried to be resolved after giving notices to both the parties. The Mediation Centre will submit its report within three months in the matter.
6. List this case on 07.07.2026 in the daily cause list alongwith the report of

Mediation Centre.

7. Till the next date of listing, the Non Bailable Warrant dated 30.08.2025 shall remain in abeyance.

8. In case the aforesaid amount is not deposited within the aforesaid period, the interim protection granted above shall automatically be vacated.
