1. Heard Sri Sudhanshu Pratap Singh, learned counsel for the applicants, learned AGA for the State and perused the record.
2. The present application under Section 528 B.N.S.S. has been filed with a prayer to allow this application and to quash/stay the entire proceedings as well as summoning order dated 16.04.2024 passed by the learned Court of Additional Civil Judge (S.D.)/Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kannauj in Complaint Case No. 2713 of 2022 (Mahendra Vs. Anju and others) under Sections 406, 323, 506 I.P.C., Police Station-Thathiya, District Kannauj, pending in the Court of Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division)/Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kannauj.
3. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that the opposite party no.2 is the father-in-law and the instant complaint has been lodged in counter blast to the FIR lodged by the applicant no.1 (daughter-in-law) i.e. FIR No. 0363 of 2022 dated 21.11.2022 under sections 498A, 323, 504, 506 IPC, Police Station Thathiya, District Kannauj. It has also been submitted that the instant complaint has been lodged with *mala fide* intent to harass the applicants. There is no injury report to substantiate the allegations.
4. Matter requires consideration.
5. Issue notice to Opposite Party No. 2, returnable at an early date.
6. Let counter affidavit be filed by the Opposite Party No. 2 within four weeks. Applicants shall have two weeks thereafter to file rejoinder

affidavit.

7. List this matter on 21.05.2026 in the daily cause list.

8. Until further orders of this Court, the proceedings of Complaint Case No. 2713 of 2022 (Mahendra Vs. Anju and others) under Sections 406, 323, 506 I.P.C., Police Station-Thathiya, District Kannauj, pending in the Court of Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division)/Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kannauj shall remain in abeyance.
