1. Case called out in the revised list.
2. No one appears on behalf of the appellants to press this appeal whereas learned AGA for the State of U.P. is present.
3. It is informed that the sole counsel for the appellants, whose name has been printed in the cause list, namely, Virendra Saran has recently died.
4. Office is directed to take appropriate steps as per rules of this Court.
5. Perusal of the office report reveals that, as per the report submitted by the learned C.J.M., Budaun (flag 'Ka'), the notices have been duly served upon appellant no. 1, Rishi Pal, whereas appellant no. 2, Ram Jit, has died.
6. On the basis of report submitted by learned C.J.M., Budaun, the instant appeal stands abated on behalf of the appellant no. 2, Ram Jit.
7. Trial court record has also not been received till date.
8. As learned counsel for the sole surviving appellant, namely, Rishi Pal is not present before this Court to argue the case. The Court, therefore, appoint Sri Gyanendra Kumar Mishra, Advocate as Amicus Curiae for appellant no. 1 / Rishi Pal
9. Office is directed to write a letter to District and Sessions Judge, Budaun to direct the concerned to transmit the lower court record as early as possible, as the instant appeal is one of the oldest pending cases in this

High Court and has been listed for priority hearing.

10. Put up this matter for hearing on **15.04.2026** subject to receipt of lower court record.
