1. Heard learned counsel for the revisionist.
2. Learned counsel for the revisionist has submitted that the order of conviction and sentence under Section 118 I.P.C. is without jurisdiction and is in violation of Section 188 IPC as well as Section 195 Cr.P.C. The proceedings, if any, under Section 188 IPC may begin on a complaint and not on FIR. He further submitted that no public order had been issued and no violation has been committed by the revisionist. The proceedings under Section 188 IPC is completely barred in view of Section 195 (2) Cr.P.C. , whereas the learned A.G.A. has submitted that the learned trial court has passed the order of conviction and sentence on the basis of confession.
3. Learned counsel for the revisionist seeks time to argue the matter.
4. Learned A.G.A. may file short counter affidavit, if any, in the meantime.
5. List this matter **on 3.2.2026**, as fresh.
