1. Heard learned counsel for the applicants, learned counsel for the informant and learned A.G.A. for the State.
2. The present 528 BNSS application has been filed to quash the entire criminal proceedings of Case No. 742 of 2025, Arising out of Case Crime No. 17/2025, Under Section 85, 115(2), 352, 351(3), 74 BNS and Section- 3/4 D.P. Act against the applicant no. 1 & 2 and Section- 85, 115(2), 352, 351(3), 74 BNS against the applicant no. 3, along with the Charge Sheet No. 29/2025, dated 30.03.2025 and the cognizance order dated 02.08.2025 Police Station- Mahila Thana, District-Sambhal, Pending before the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate, Sambhal now Chandausi on the basis of compromise dated 28.07.2025..
3. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that parties have reconciled their differences and compromise have entered between them which has been reduced in writing. Applicant No.1 is husband of opposite party No.2. Compromise deed has been filed as annexure 4 to the affidavit.
4. Learned counsel appearing for the opposite party no. 2/informant does not dispute the correctness of the facts and submitted that opposite party No.2 does not want to pursue the case further against the applicants.
5. The parties are directed to appear before the trial court within six weeks from today along with a certified copy of this order and photocopy of compromise deed, thereafter, trial court shall verify the parties and

compromise deed, entered into between the parties, and pass an appropriate order to that effect, thereafter, trial court shall immediately transmit the said order to this Hon'ble Court within two weeks.

6. List after eight weeks.

7. Till the next date of listing, no coercive action shall be taken against the applicants.
