1. Heard Mr. Mukesh Joshi, learned counsel for the applicants, learned AGA for the State and perused the record.
2. The present application under Section 528 BNSS has been filed with a prayer to allow this application and quash the impugned summoning order dated 23.10.2009 as well as entire proceeding of the case no. 8161 of 2007 (Shankar Vs. Mangla Prasad and others), Under Section 147, 395, 504, 506 IPC, Police Station-Civil Lines, District Rampur, pending in the court of learned Additional Civil Judge-I, Rampur.
3. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the applicants that the applicants have been falsely implicated being the landlord and a tenancy dispute is pending between the parties. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that the co-accused have already been given the relief vide order dated 22.09.2010 in Application U/s 482 No. 30181 of 2010 (Ram Kishore Gaur and Others v. State of U.P. and another).
4. Matter requires consideration.
5. Issue notice to opposite party No. 2, returnable at an early date.
6. Connect and list with Application U/s 482 No. 30181 of 2010 (Ram Kishore Gaur and Others v. State of U.P. and another).
7. Opposite party No. 2 may file counter-affidavit within four weeks. Rejoinder-affidavit be filed within two weeks thereafter.

8. Until further orders, the entire proceedings of the case no. 8161 of 2007 (Shankar Vs. Mangla Prasad and others), Under Section 147, 395, 504, 506 IPC, Police Station-Civil Lines, District Rampur, pending in the court of learned Additional Civil Judge-I, Rampur, shall be kept in abeyance.
