1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned Additional Government Advocate appearing on behalf of the State.
2. Mr. Praveen Kumar Srivastava, Advocate, has filed his vakalatnama on behalf of opposite party no. 2 today, which is taken on record.
3. In compliance with the earlier order passed by this Court, the applicant (wife) and opposite party no. 2 (husband) are present in person before the Court. Upon query, opposite party no. 2 (husband) has stated that he is willing to keep the applicant as his wife. He has further assured the Court that he shall bring his wife from her parental home within two days and thereafter take her with him to the place of his posting in the State of Orrisa. He has, therefore, prayed for ten days' time to make necessary arrangements for accommodation at the said place.
4. Since the husband has shown bona fide intention to keep his wife with him at his place of posting in the State of Orrisa, and as there appears to be every likelihood of reconciliation between the parties, the time as prayed for is granted. However, it is made clear that the parents or relatives of either party shall not interfere in the peaceful marital life of the parties. In the event any hindrance or obstruction is caused by any parent or relative of either party, the

concerned police authorities shall take appropriate action against the wrongdoers strictly in accordance with law.

5. List the case on 18.02.2026. On the next date, both parties shall again appear before this Court in person.
