HON'BLE NALIN KUMAR SRIVASTAVA, J.

1. Learned counsel for the applicant and learned A.G.A. are present.
2. The FIR of this case reveals that four named accused persons having lathi, danda etc. came to the house of the informant and made assault upon the informant side. They sustained serious injuries. Satpal, the uncle of the informant sustained serious head injuries and he died subsequently. FIR was lodged and during investigation the I.O. interrogated some independent witnesses and on the basis of their statements closure report was submitted in this matter against the present accused applicant whereas charge sheet was submitted in respect of other co-accused persons. During trial the evidence of P.W.1/ informant / injured was recorded and on the basis of his statement the accused was summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C., however, the said order was challenged by way of criminal revision but the same was dismissed.
3. Prima facie, it appears that the active role and participation of the present accused comes on surface in the statement of P.W.1/ informant/ injured.
4. The matter requires consideration.
5. Issue notice to opposite party no.2 returnable within three weeks at the address given in the application. Opposite party no.2 may file counter affidavit within three weeks. Learned A.G.A. may also file counter affidavit within the same period. Rejoinder affidavit, if any, may thereafter be filed within a week.
6. Put up this case as fresh on 25.02.2026.
