HON'BLE SAMEER JAIN, J.

1. Sri Udayveer Singh, Advocate filed his power on behalf of the informant which is taken on record.
2. Sri Ranjeet Singh, learned counsel for the applicant, Sri Udayveer Singh, learned counsel for the informant and Sri Manoj Kumar Singh, learned brief holder for the State are present.
3. At the very outset, learned counsel appearing for the informant submits, applicant is husband of the deceased and on his demand about one month before death of the deceased her father transferred Rs.1 Lakh in account of applicant, therefore, a week's time may be given to him to file counter affidavit disclosing this fact.
4. Learned AGA also submits, he may also be permitted to file counter affidavit within ten days.
5. In view of the above, case is passed over for the day.
6. List this case on 17.02.2026 in the daily cause list amongst top ten cases showing the name of Sri Udayveer Singh as counsel for the informant.
7. In the meantime, learned AGA as well as learned counsel for the

informant may file counter affidavit.

8. Rejoinder affidavit, if any, may also be filed, in the meantime.
