HON'BLE RAJIV LOCHAN SHUKLA, J.

1. Learned A.G.A. has raised a preliminary objection that the applicant's anticipatory bail application was earlier dismissed by the Sessions Judge, Bareilly, vide order dated 23.12.2024; however, the present anticipatory bail application has been filed on 27.01.2026, and no explanation has been given with respect to the excessive delay in approaching this Court seeking anticipatory bail. He further submits that nothing has been brought on record to show the immediate apprehension of arrest of the applicant.

2. On such objection being raised, learned counsel for the applicant prays that he may be granted time to file a supplementary affidavit, supplementing the pleadings.

3. Time, so sought, is granted.

4. Put up as fresh on 17.02.2026 before the appropriate Court.

5. It is made clear that this application shall not be treated as tied up or part-heard before this Bench.
