HON'BLE JITENDRA KUMAR SINHA, J.

1. Heard Sri Bhavisya Sharma, learned counsel for the applicant, Sri B.P. Maurya, learned A.G.A. for the State and perused the record.
2. The present application has been moved seeking anticipatory bail in Case Crime no. 1636 of 2025 under Sections 409, 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, Police Station Mursan, District Hathras with the prayer that in the event of arrest, the applicant may be released on bail.
3. It is contended by learned counsel for the applicant that applicant was granted interim protection from arrest by Division Bench of this Court vide order dated 24.9.2024 passed in Crl. Misc. Writ Petition No. 17138 of 2024. It is further submitted that now cognizance has been taken and the applicant has been summoned to face trial.
4. On the other hand, learned A.G.A. submits that he has not received instructions in the matter as yet.
5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, let the applicant **Bhupendra Pathak** in the event of his arrest, be released on interim anticipatory bail on his furnishing a personal bond of Rs. 50,000/- with two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Court concerned **till 23.2.2026** with the following conditions :-

- (i) The applicant shall not tamper with evidence and that he would appear

before the trial Court on the date fixed unless exempted by the Court concerned;

(ii) The applicant shall not directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her/them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;

(iii) The applicant would co-operate during trial and would not misuse the liberty of bail.

(iv) The applicant shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court concerned.

6. In default of any of the conditions, the prosecution shall be at liberty to file appropriate application for cancellation of the interim anticipatory bail granted to the applicant.

7. Put up this case as fresh on 23.2.2026.

8. In the meantime, learned AGA is directed to obtain instructions in the matter by the next date fixed.
