HON'BLE RAJIV LOCHAN SHUKLA, J.

1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant, learned A.G.A. for the State and Sri Padmaker Pandey, learned counsel for the informant.
2. The present anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of the applicant in Case Crime No. 0161 of 2025, under Sections 3(5), 118(1), 351(3), 352, 115(2), 109, 333, 190, 191(3), 191(2) of B.N.S., Police Station-Sahaswan, District-Budaun, with a prayer to enlarge him on anticipatory bail, during the pendency of trial.
3. Learned counsel for the applicant states that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the present case. Similarly situated co-accused Kamil Hussain, has been granted interim anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 09.09.2025. He states that no counter affidavit has been in that case by the learned A.G.A. and learned counsel for the informant. The applications of co-accused Kamil Hussain and Mohammad Fazil are pending consideration of this Court and it would be appropriate that all the cases are heard together as interim anticipatory bail have been granted to the co-accused and the case of the applicant stand on a similar footing to that of the co-accused.
4. The learned counsel for the informant has no objection to the same.
5. In view of the statement so made, connect with Criminal Misc. Anticipatory Bail Application U/S 482 BNSS No. - 6894 of 2025 and 583

of 2026 and list before the appropriate Court on **06.04.2026**.

6. Matter shall not be treated as part heard to tied up to this court.

7. Taking into account the fact that the similarly situated co-accused has been granted interim anticipatory bail by this court, till the next date of listing, in the event of arrest of the applicant-**Suhail Husain @ Sohil Husain** involved in the aforesaid case crime, he shall be released on **interim anticipatory bail** on his furnishing a personal bond and two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Station House Officer of the police station/Court concerned with the following conditions:-

(i) The applicant shall not tamper with evidence and that he would appear before the trial Court on the date fixed unless exempted by the Court concerned;

(ii) The applicant shall not directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her/them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;

(iii) The applicant would co-operate during trial and would not misuse the liberty of bail.

(iv) The applicant shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court concerned.

(v) that the applicant shall not pressurize/intimidate the prosecution witness;

8. In default of any of the conditions, the prosecution shall be at liberty to file appropriate application for cancellation of interim anticipatory bail granted to the applicant.

9. Counter affidavit may be filed in this case also in the meantime.
