1. Heard Shri Gaurav Yadav, holding brief of Shri Keshari Nath Tripathi, learned counsel for the petitioners, learned A.G.A. and perused the record.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner No. 1 is a major girl aged about 20 years. Learned counsel for the petitioner has next submitted that she, out of her own free-will and consent, had gone with the petitioner no. 2 and has already married with petitioner no. 2 on 3.1.2026 and is now living peacefully with him.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has next submitted that there is nothing on record to show that the petitioner No. 1 was forcibly taken away and compelled to marry with petitioner no. 2 and as such, prima facie no offence is disclosed against the petitioners as such the impugned F.I.R is liable to be quashed.
4. Matter requires consideration.
5. Issue notice to respondent no. 4 returnable within four weeks.
6. Learned AGA may also file counter affidavit within the said period. Rejoinder affidavit, if any, may be filed within one week thereafter.
7. List on 20.4.2026 before the appropriate Bench.
8. Till then, the petitioners shall not be arrested in pursuance of the

impugned F.I.R. dated 6.1.2026 arising out of case crime no. 7 of 2026, under sections 87 BNS, P.S. Nahtaur, District Bijnor.
