1. Heard learned counsel for the revisionist.

2. Learned counsel for the revisionist submits that opposite party no. 2/Smt. Gargi Arora has filed an application under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. seeking summoning of opposite party nos. 1, Raj Kumar Arora, 2, Anil Arora; 3, Neeru Arora; and 4, Harsh Arora, under Sections 354-B, 323, 420, 406, 424, 427, 504 and 506 I.P.C. The said complaint was registered, and after recording the statements under Sections 200 and 202 Cr.P.C., only the revisionist, namely Anil Arora, who is the jeth of opposite party no. 2/complainant, was summoned under Section 354 I.P.C. only.

3. No offence, as alleged by the complainant in her complaint, has been found to be made out. No offence was found against the other opposite parties except the revisionist. There was no medical examination of the complainant. There exists a property dispute between the parties, as stated by the revisionist in paragraph 11 of the affidavit filed in support of the memo of the present criminal revision.

4. Prima facie, the matter appears to be a property dispute among the members of the family.

5. Matter requires consideration.

6. Issue notice to the opposite party no. 2 returnable at an early date.

7. List after four weeks as fresh.

8. Meanwhile, the further proceedings of the Complaint Case No. 7261 of 2021, Smt.Gargi Arora Versus Raj Kumar Arora and others, under section 354 I.P.C., Police Station Kavi Nagar, District Ghaziabad, shall remain stayed till the next date of listing.

9. The revisionist is hereby directed to take steps by speed post/registered AD within 48 hours and file supplementary affidavit in compliance thereof within a week, failing

which the appropriate order for vacation of interim order may be passed on the next date.
