1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Standing Counsel for the State-respondents.
2. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners that both the petitioners are major and they have solemnized their marriage on 15.01.2026, and they have apprehension of life threat from the respondent no.4.
3. On the other hand, the learned Standing Counsel states that the date of birth of petitioner no. 2, as per the Aadhaar card, is 01.01.2006, and that he is just above 20 years of age and thus not of marriageable age. Consequently, the marriage of the petitioners is contended to be a voidable marriage. She prays for and is granted two weeks' time to enable her to obtain instructions in the matter.
4. Put up this case on 19.02.2026 as fresh.
5. Till the next date of listing, respondent no.2, Superintendent of Police, District Prayagraj is directed to ensure that no harassment is made to the petitioners at the behest of respondent no. 4 and his family members.
