1. Heard Sri Bhagwan Dutt Pandey, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, Sri Jagannath Singh, learned counsel for respondent no. 5 and Sri Rajesh Kumar Srivastava, learned Standing Counsel for State respondents.
2. Learned counsel for respondent no. 5 submits that he has filed counter affidavit on 09.02.2026 which is not available on record.
