1. Heard learned counsel for the applicants, learned counsel for the opposite party no. 2, learned A.G.A for the State and perused the record.

2. Learned counsel for the applicants contended that at page 10 of the supplementary affidavit dated 29.10.2025, the copy of compromise is annexed as annexure no.1. It is argued that as such the present proceedings be quashed. The learned counsel for opposite party no. 2 has also submits his consent on it.

3. Looking to the facts of the case, both the parties are directed to appear before the court concerned and shall file the said compromise duly signed by all the parties for verification within a period of three weeks from today. Thereafter, the court concerned shall verify the same within three weeks and send his report to this Court.

4. List after eight weeks.

5. Till the next date of listing, no coercive action shall be taken against the applicants in Case No. 31109 of 2023 (State Vs. Aman and Others) relating to Case Crime No. 10 of 2023, under Sections 498A, 323, 506, 354, 354-B IPC and Section 3/4 D.P. Act, P.S. Binawar, District Budaun, pending in the court of learned 7th Additional Civil Judge (Junior Division)/Judicial Magistrate, Budaun.

6. Learned counsels for the parties are also at liberty to file the

order of compromise through an affidavit in the present matter.
