1. Compliance affidavit filed by the State is taken on record.
2. Sri Vinod Kumar Yadav, learned counsel for the applicant, Sri Mohit Behari Mathur, learned counsel for the informant and Sri R.N. Srivastava, learned AGA for the State are present.
3. At the very outset, learned counsel for the informant submits, there are serious allegation of cheating and misappropriation of money against applicant and applicant duped the informant and his more than Rs.57 lakh has been embezzled and even apart from the present case he is also having criminal history relating to cases of cheating and therefore two weeks' time may be given to him to file counter affidavit.
4. Considering the averments made by learned counsel for the informant, two weeks' time is given to the informant to file counter affidavit.
5. In the meantime, learned AGA shall also file counter affidavit disclosing the entire relevant facts including the criminal history of the applicant. Rejoinder affidavit, if any,

may be filed within two weeks thereafter.

6. List this case on 20.04.2026 in the top ten cases under the category of daily cause list.
