1. Learned counsel for the parties are present.
2. Sri Rajiv Gaur, Advocate holding brief of Sri Anand Prakash Srivastava, learned counsel for the revisionist, Sri Daya Shanker Yadav, learned counsel for opposite party no. 2 and learned A.G.A. for the State are present.
3. It was apprised by learned counsel for the revisionist that an award of Rs. 5,000/- was passed vide order dated 03.08.2024 by the Additional Principal Judge, Family Court No. 2, Azamgarh as maintenance to be paid by the revisionist to opposite party no. 2, which is on higher side and the complainant has deposited only a little amount towards the satisfaction of the amount of award.
4. On the other hand, learned counsel for opposite party no. 2 states that till date, only payment of Rs. 1500/- has been made on account of award passed in favour of opposite party no. 2. It was also apprised that the recovery proceedings have been initiated against the revisionist before the trial court for recovery of approximately Rs. 3,20,000/-
5. The revisionist is directed to pay a lump-sum amount of Rs. 50,000/- to opposite party no. 2 and he is also directed to pay Rs. 3,000/- per month to opposite party no 2 on or before 10th of each month towards the amount of maintenance.

6. List on 21.05.2026.

7. The revisionist is directed to file compliance affidavit regarding deposition of amount of Rs. 50,000/- in favour of opposite party no. 2 by the next date.

8. Till the next date of listing, no coercive measures shall be adopted against the revisionist with regard to impugned judgement and order dated 03.08.2024 passed by learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court No. 2, Azamgarh in Case No. 794 of 2020 (Khushboo Singh Vs. Vivek Kumar Singh) under Section 125 Cr.P.C., Police Station Mubarakpur, District Azamgarh.

9. If by the next date, above direction is not complied with by the revisionist, protection granted today, shall stand vacated.

10. In the meantime, counter-affidavit, if any, may be filed by learned counsel for opposite party no. 2.
