**HON'BLE DINESH PATHAK, J.**

1. It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the placement of the petitioner's chak No. 656 has been changed from the east to west and petitioner has been deprived of his Sahan land.
2. Per contra, learned counsel for the respondent No. 3 has contended that, owing to the order passed by Consolidation Officer, chak of the respondent No. 3 (chak No. 143) became multi-cornered, which was rightly corrected by the Settlement Officer of Consolidation and affirmed by the Deputy Director of Consolidation.
3. Be that as it may, the matter requires consideration.
4. State-respondents No. 1, 2 and 4 are represented through learned Standing Counsel. Private-respondent No. 3 is represented through his counsel as well. They have prayed for and are granted three weeks time to file counter affidavit in the matter. The petitioner will have two weeks, thereafter, for filing rejoinder affidavit, if any.
5. List this matter on 02.04.2026.
6. Improvement/development, if any, over the plot in question shall be subject to the decision of the instant writ petition.
