HON'BLE VINOD DIWAKAR, J.

1. The instant revision has been preferred against the impugned judgment and order dated 16.01.2026 passed by the learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Kanpur Nagar in Case No. 1906 of 2025, *Varun Vishwakarma alias Varun Kumar Sharma v. Smt. Sonam Vishwakarma*, under Section 126(2) of Cr.P.C., Police Station–Rawatpur, District Kanpur Nagar, whereby the learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Kanpur Nagar, allowed the recall application subject to the condition that the revisionist shall pay 40% of the outstanding maintenance amount.

2. Learned counsel for the revisionist submits that an *ex-parte* order was passed by the learned Family Court vide order dated 30.07.2025, whereby maintenance to the tune of Rs.10,000/- per month was awarded in favour of the respondent-wife. It is further submitted that the said *ex-parte* order was passed without proper service of notice upon the revisionist at his correct residential address. Therefore, the impugned order passed under Section 126(2) Cr.P.C. is erroneous and liable to be set-aside.

3. Upon perusal of the impugned order, it is observed that vide order dated 24.03.2025, the learned Family Court proceeded with the matter *ex-parte* against the revisionist.

4. Learned counsel for the revisionist seeks and is granted two weeks' time to place on record the certified copy of the order dated 24.03.2025, whereby the learned Family Court proceeded *ex-parte*, along with the *Tamila* report, by means of a supplementary affidavit.

5. List this case as fresh on 12.05.2026.
