1. Learned counsel for the appellant and Sri R.K. Singh, learned AGA for the State.
2. Learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that the appellant is a lady who is presently posted as an Assistant Teacher. Learned counsel further submits that the respondent/complainant obtained the Transfer Certificate (TC) of her daughter in the year 2020 and thereafter raised objections, alleging that the date of birth mentioned in the TC is incorrect. The allegations are false and concocted. There was no reason for the complainant to approach the appellant for correction of the date of birth in the TC.
3. Considering the nature of the allegations, this Court finds it expedient to stay the proceedings of Special Case No. 78 of 2023 (Banny Singh vs. Teacher Mamta Sharma and another), under Sections 323, 504, and 506 of the IPC, and Section 3(1)(Da) & (Dha) of the SC/ST Act, at Police Station Jamunapar, District Mathura, till the next date of listing.
