**HON'BLE PRAVEEN KUMAR GIRI, J.**

1. Shri Sudhakar Shukla, learned counsel for the revisionist submits that he has filed the instant criminal revision with the relief which has been mentioned in the prayer clause of the revision.

2. The relief which has been mentioned in the revision is delineated below:-

*"It is, therefore, most respectfully prayed that this Hon'ble Court may graciously be pleased to enhance the amount as claimed by the revisionists in the application U/s 125 Cr.P.C. awarded at least Rs.30000/- per month to revisionists instead of Rs.6000/- so that justice may be done."*

3. Learned counsel for the revisionist submits that by the order of interim maintenance, Rs.6,000/- per month has been granted to the wife. However, it has been directed that the said amount shall not be payable separately and Rs.6,000/- per month granted to the wife under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act in the divorce petition towards litigation expenses shall be adjusted towards the aforesaid amount of Rs.6,000/- per month.

4. Learned counsel for the revisionist further submits that the amount awarded under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act cannot be merged with the interim maintenance amount, as the amount under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act is granted towards expenses to contest the case

and not as maintenance. However, treating it as maintenance, the amount has been merged in the interim maintenance order and, thus, effectively no maintenance order has been passed in favour of the revisionist, while opposite party No.2 is owner/proprietor/director of Rasin Global Private Limited and is earning substantially much higher amount.

5. Matter requires consideration.

6. Issue notice to opposite party No.2 for filing counter affidavit.

7. Counter affidavit shall be filed within four weeks. Rejoinder affidavit may be filed within a week thereafter.

8. List this case as fresh on 14.05.2026.
